

**MINUTES OF THE DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE (DDC) MEETING HELD ON 13/12/2021 AT THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE TINSUKIA**

The DDC meeting was presided over by Shri Narsing Pawar, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, and Tinsukia. At the very outset of the meeting the Chairman & Deputy Commissioner welcomed all the Departmental Heads of the district.

1. **Food & Civil Supplies Department:** The Deputy Director, Food & Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, on query from the Chair, informed the house that from the last DDC meeting, they have made 21,133 nos of progress regarding the Adhar enrolment in the District. The Chairman opined that the no of progress is less and they need to increase the manpower for Adhar generation and adhar seeding purpose. The Deputy Commissioner directed the Deputy Director to engage manpower shift wise to speed up the progress dividing into 6 (six) hours per shift and also made arrangements for creating additional Log in Id and password. For manpower, the Chairman asked to include the election workers and those who worked for NRC. The Deputy Commissioner set the deadline of 31<sup>st</sup> January 2021 for complete Adhar generation and Adhar seeding. The Hon'ble Chairman stated that covid vaccination and adhar generation must go hand in hand. He opined that awareness should be generated among common people through IEC so that people come out in bulks for both availing vaccine and adhar enrolment. The Chairman also stated that those, whose names are not included in the electoral list, form 6 are to be made available for inclusion of their names in the electoral rolls.

The Deputy Director further informed the house that 50 nos of POS machines have been received and officers are also trained.

Regarding Paddy Procurement Centre, the Deputy Director apprised that infrastructure building of Tinsukia and Kakopather PPC has been completed and for Makum PPC, construction works are undergoing.

2. **Health & Family Welfare:** The Joint director of Health services apprised that total no's of active cases in the district till date were 10(ten), of which 6 are under home isolation. The Deputy Commissioner directed him to increase the number of covid testing in the probable risk areas. For Covid vaccination, the Chairman directed the Joint director of Health services to organise camps in centrally located areas covering all the GPs and wards with a minimum target of 15,000 per day for second dose of vaccination.



On query from the Chair, the Joint Director informed that there is an overdue of 85,000 of vaccination in the district. The Deputy Commissioner directed him to complete the overdue within one week.

Regarding the 'Buniadi Swasthya' Kendra in each LAC, the ADC, Revenue informed the house that land has not been fixed till date.

3. **Education:** The IS informed the house that no reply from govt has been received till date against the 40 no's of proposals for merger and amalgamation of schools that has been sent. The chairman directed the IS to tackle the issues arising out for admission soon. The IS further informed the house that one covid case has been detected from Majgaon High School infecting a teacher. The Chairman directed both the DEEO and IS to strictly follow the SOP and covid 19 protocols in the schools. He stated that before opening the Anganwadi Centres, there must be proper sensitization in the centres.
4. **Fishery:** The DFDO informed the house that survey is going on to create one community pond in each village in convergence with MGNREGA. The DFDO also apprised that the hatchery at Kakopather can be inaugurated by next week.
5. **Transport :** The DTO apprised the house that 51 crores of target for revenue collection has been achieved in the district
6. **Irrigation:** The Deputy Commissioner directed the Ex. Eng Irrigation to expedite the works under PMKSY. The Deputy Commissioner also directed him to plan out a survey on the irrigated land in the district.
7. **APDCL:** The Chairman directed all the BDO's to pay the outstanding power bills immediately if any. He also directed the CEO, APDCL to provide the list of offices which have outstanding liabilities by the day itself. The Chair however directed the CEO, APDCL not to cut power connections of GP Offices and Adhar centres without informing the district administration and concerned authorities.
8. **Agriculture:** The Deputy Commissioner directed the DAO, Tinsukia to erase the ineligible and untraceable beneficiaries from the PM-KISAN beneficiaries list. Only eligible beneficiaries should be reflected in the portal. The Chairman opined that poorest of the poor people should be included in the beneficiary list. The DAO informed the house that they received 27 nos of applications for mini trucks and power tiller. The ADC,

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Agriculture asked the DAO to submit the FPO list with member details by next week.

9. **PWD ( Tinsukia, Sadiya, Margherita territorial road division) :** The Ex. Eng. Apprised the house that progress under PMGSY is 88% and progress under non- PMGSY is 79% for the year 2019-20. The Chairman directed the Ex. Eng. To complete the works within the month of February 2022. The Ex. Eng. also informed that NOC from forest for the road from Dhola to Kesaikhaiti and saikhowa to Hakhhati has not been received yet.
10. **PWD Building:** The Deputy Commissioner directed the Ex. Eng of PWD (B) to submit the proposal for integrated DC Office. The Ex. Eng of PWD (B) apprised the house that hand over of land for Beer Raghav Moran College has not been done till now. The Chairman directed CO, Doomdooma to expedite the matter.
11. **Sericulture and Handloom & Textile :** The Chairman directed both the Assistant director of Sericulture and Superintendent of Handloom & Textile to work together for fruitful results. The Chairman stressed on the importance of convergence between these two departments. He further stated that for market linkages of products expo can be organised in the district. The district administration will offer handholding supports with regards to equipments, training etc.
12. **Soil conservation:** The District Officer Soil Conservation informed the house that under SOPD-G block plantation at Kuhiyarbari, Miri Chapori, Sunpura Nadikinar for the year 2020-21 is going on.
13. **Excise:** The Superintendant of Excise apprised the house that out of 236 core target of revenue collection, 101 cores has already been collected. The Chairman directed to identify areas where police team is needed.
14. **Wildlife :** The Chairman strictly directed the DFO, wildlife to stop the fishing activities in the eco sensitive zones nearby Guijan ghat area. The Chairman apprised that it has come to the noticed that no action has been taken against such activities. So the Deputy Commissioner directed him to take strict actions.
15. **Panchayat & Rural Development :** The Deputy Commissioner directed all the BDOs to complete the works under PMAY-G against those for which only release of 3<sup>rd</sup> instalment is pending. The gap between the release of third



instalment and completion must be zero. If any case of misuse of fund is found, FIR should be lodged against such beneficiaries.

16. **Labour:** The Deputy Commissioner & Chairman directed the Asst. Labour Commissioner to implement the scheme E-Shram in the district and take steps in the implementation of PMSVa nidhi scheme if possible.

At the end of the meeting the Deputy Commissioner requested all the HODs to achieve the monitorable targets from the office of Hon'ble CM Assam.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
